The following information will help you plan your travel to the ground and offer transport tips around Cardiff to make your visits as enjoyable as possible.

- Plan both your journey to and from the ground and purchase your train tickets or parking in advance.
- Allow enough time for your journey and getting to the ground, the surrounding area can get extremely busy near the start of the match.
- If you plan to travel by car, please also check www.trafficengland.com or <https://traffic.wales> to make sure the planned roadworks do not affect your planned route.

GETTING TO CARDIFF WALES STADIUM



... BY TRAIN

Cardiff Central rail station operates an extensive service to Cardiff from London, Birmingham and services from all over Wales. It is approximately a 20 minute walk to the ground. Our World Cup Cricketers will be there to welcome you, help answer any questions and guide you to the ground! For information about train times please visit; www.nationalrail.co.uk



... BY PARK & RIDE

Cardiff City Stadium (Cardiff East) Park & Ride will operate on all matchdays. It is a 15 minute bus journey and costs £15 per vehicle, which includes the shuttle which goes directly to the ground. Postcode: CF11 8EG.



The car park opens 3 hours before the first ball and the bus service to the ground starts 2.5 hours before. It will run intermittently until 30 minutes after the first ball. The shuttle will start from the ground one hour before close of play.



... CAR PARKING

There is no parking at the ground. If you are driving it is recommended to use the Park & Ride or use one of the public car parks in and around the city centre. Please see www.cardiff.gov.uk for more information on parking locations and prices.



... BY PRIVATE COACH

... BY BUS

Cardiff and the Sophia Gardens area are well serviced by the local bus network. There are stops on Cathedral Road either side of Sophia Close.

The popular routes going via Cathedral Road from the city centre include:

- No. 25 Circular Service to Llandaff North
- No. 62 Service to Llandaff
- No. 63 service to Radyr and Morganstown

... ACTIVE TRAVEL

WALK If you are local to the area, walking is a great way to get around and is a short walk from the city centre through Bute Park. World Cup Cricketers will be along the route to help answer any questions and guide you to the ground!



CYCLE If you choose to cycle to the match there are publicly available bike racks in the city centre and the Sophia Gardens area.



... BY DROP OFF & PICK UP / TAXI, PRIVATE HIRE, UBER

Cardiff Wales Stadium has the following designated drop off and pick up points:

- Taxi's – Cathedral Road
- Private Hire – Pontcanna Fields Car Park
- Uber - Pontcanna Fields Car Park
- Friends/family - Pontcanna Fields Car Park

Pontcanna Fields Car Park is located off Fields Park Road (CF11 9JP) and is a short walk to the ground.

There will not be any access to Sophia Close to drop off or pick up.



... BY TRAVEL OPTIONS IF YOU HAVE ACCESSIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

BLUE BADGE PARKING There is blue badge parking at the venue which will need to be booked in advance by contacting the venue directly on 02920 409380 or email info@glamorganccricket.co.uk.

It is recommended to be parked 60 minutes before the first ball and will need to stay in place until 30 minutes after the final ball for health and safety reasons.

PARK & RIDE All the park & ride shuttles to and from the venue are accessible.

PUBLIC BUSES Majority of the public transport buses in Cardiff are accessible and drop off close to the venue on Cathedral Road. For more information on local buses, please visit www.travelinecymru.info.
