Bristol County Ground is in the Bishopston neighbourhood and is approximately 2.5 miles from the city centre.

The following information will help you plan your travel to the cricket ground and offer transport tips around Bristol to make your visit as enjoyable as possible.

- Plan both your journey to and from the ground and purchase your train tickets or accommodation well in advance. Staying overnight might be a good option.
- Allow enough time for your journey and getting to the venue, the surrounding area can get extremely busy near the start of the match.
- Use the [Journey Planner](#) to help plan your journey using public transport.
- If you plan to travel to Bristol by car please also check www.trafficengland.com to make sure planned roadworks do not affect your journey.

GETTING TO BRISTOL COUNTY GROUND



... BY PARK & RIDE

Bristol Parkway Train Station offers excellent rail connections as well as extensive parking and will also serve as a Park & Ride site. The parking at the station, as well as the adjacent Stoke Gifford car park, will be available for all CWC 2019 matches.



The Park & Ride shuttles will stop at Ashley Down Road which is approx. 300m from the venue entrance. The shuttle will commence service from Bristol Parkway Station 3 hours prior to match start and the return service from the cricket ground back to Parkway will resume 30 minutes before close of play.

Park & Ride shuttles are accessible and will be free of charge to match ticket and accreditation holders. Information about parking at Bristol Parkway and payment options can be found here: [APCOA Bristol](#).



... CAR PARKING

Due to the location of the venue there will be no parking at the ground and the surrounding residential area. We strongly recommend you use public transport, active travel or Park & Ride services.



... BY BUS

The existing public bus network in Bristol is excellent and the roads around the ground benefit from many regular services from both Bristol train stations as well as the city centre. Local buses to the cricket ground stop on Gloucester Road (for access to the Grace Gate via Nevil Road):

- Bus no. 71 and 72: service UWE Campuses via Temple Meads and City Centre;
- Bus no.73: from Temple Meads to Bristol Parkway via City Centre;
- Buses no. 75 and 76: from Cribbs Causeway to Hartcliffe & Hengrove via City Centre;
- Intercity buses: Severn Express and T2.

... BY TRAIN

The County Ground is located approximately 2.5 miles from Bristol Temple Meads station and 4.5 miles from Bristol Parkway station. Both stations are frequently serviced by an extensive rail network from London, Cardiff and further afield.

A free shuttle service will be available on match days between Bristol Parkway station and the ground. Local bus services 71, 72 and 73 operate between the venue and Bristol Temple Meads Station.

The nearest train station to the ground is Montpellier station which is approx. 1 mile walk from the venue. The station serves the Severn Beach Line which operates twice hourly services from Bristol Temple Meads to Severn Beach.

... ACTIVE TRAVEL

WALK Our World Cup Cricketers will welcome you and offer support and information at Bristol Parkway station, as well as near the ground on Gloucester Road and College Road.



... DROP OFF & PICK UP / TAXI, PRIVATE HIRE, UBER

Designated taxi ranks will be on Gloucester Road just off Nevil Road (Grace Gate exit).

Drop Off and Pick up for private hire and Uber will be on Arthur Milton St just off Ashley Down Road (Ashley Down Gate exit).



... TRAVEL OPTIONS IF YOU HAVE ACCESSIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

BLUE BADGE PARKING is very limited at the cricket ground and is pre-bookable only. There is limited space and spaces are allocated on a first come first serve basis. To book a Blue Badge space please contact the venue reception on 0117 910 8000 or email reception@glosccc.co.uk.

OTHER OPTIONS Both the existing local buses which operate on Gloucester Road and the Park & Ride shuttles from Bristol Parkway station are accessible and each bus has space for at least one wheelchair.
